

NEED ASSISTANCE WITH CARE AND HOUSING?



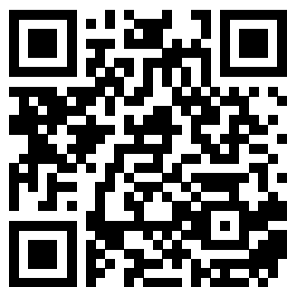
Our **Assistance with Care and Housing (ACH)** program is designed to support people who are homeless or at risk of homelessness, to access appropriate and sustainable housing as well as community care and other support services.

You may be eligible if you are:









- aged 50 years and over, or 45 years and over for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people
- on a low income
- homeless or at risk of homelessness as a result of experiencing housing stress or not having secure accommodation.
