



COMMUNITY VISITOR SCHEME

The Community Visitors Scheme (CVS) supports community based organisations to recruit and match volunteers to provide friendship and companionship through voluntary social visits.

The CVS is a government initiative that supports volunteers to provide social visits to older people. The CVS is a free service available for people who:

- Receive government-funded residential aged care or Home Care Packages
- Do not have regular and reasonable, frequent and positive contact with friends or relatives.
- Are socially isolated
- Have frailty, mobility or communication issues that may prevent them from participating in social activities.

A volunteer visitor will visit for a minimum of 1 hour per fortnight to provide direct social support to a participant.
